ENTRY PROCEDURES:

1. **CLOSING DATE:** 13 January 2013 – **NO** late entries will be accepted
2. Entries will be made on the entry form at the end of the schedule.
3. ALL payments for these classes must be sent to the Bank Details given on the breed specific entry form. These payments should include Kyalami Park Club temporary membership and stabling fees where applicable.
4. Proof of payment should accompany all entry forms received, Please pay an extra 10% for cash deposits
5. The age of the horse and rider calculated as per AQHA rules (see www.aqha.com)
6. Entry fees: Halter classes – R160
Ridden Classes – R180

STABLING: – (brick and temporary)

Stabling is booked on the stabling form at the end of the schedule. Limited stabling is available at the fee of R150.00 per night per stable. Preference will be given to will be given to outlying regions, thereafter it will be allocated on a first come first serve basis. People wishing to be stabled with others, should indicate this on their form. Stabling should be paid with entry fees were applicable.

ALL HORSES ARE STABLED AT OWNERS RISK

MEMBERSHIP AND REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Competitors and Owners must ensure that they are members in good standing of SAQHA.
Temporary SAQHA Day memberships: R250
2. Temporary Kyalami Park Club membership available and compulsory for ALL COMPETITORS those who are NOT members Kyalami Park Club at a cost of R85.00 per competitor for the duration of the show. Temporary membership should be included with your entry fees to go to SAQHA.
3. All horses competing should be registered with SAQHA
4. IN ACCORDANCE WITH DEPT OF AGRICULTURE GOVERNMENT GAZETTE DOC NO. R. 885 & ANIMAL DISEASES ACT 1984 (ACT 35 OF 1984) "ALL EQUINES IN THE REPUBLIC EXCEPT EQUINES IN THE AFRICAN HORSES SICKNESS FREE ZONE AND SURVEILLANCE ZONE, AS DESCRIBED IN ANNEXURE 4, SHALL BETWEEN AGES OF 6 AND 9 MONTHS, THEN BETWEEN THE AGES OF 12 AND 15 MONTHS AND THEN AGAIN ONCE EVERY YEAR THEREAFTER BE IMMUNISED WITH AN EFFECTIVE REMEDY BY THE RESPONSIBLE PERSON: PROVIDED THAT IMMUNISATION MUST BE CARRIED OUT BY AN OFFICER OR VETERINARIAN" In keeping with this rule and regulations of SAEF, all exhibitors must produce, on entry to the show, proof of immunization of African Horse Sickness and Equine Flu.
5. Competitors should note that **NO REFUND** will be made to competitors whose entry cannot be accepted due to incorrect registration and membership. **IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY** to ensure that all the above is correct.

REFUNDS:

Full refunds will be given if the entry is not accepted by the Society or Show Holding Body due to the classes being under / over subscribed, or if the classes are cancelled prior to the start of the show

TIMETABLE:

A provisional timetable appears at the end of the schedule as a guide. Competitors are advised to check with Kyalami Park Club Office or SASA Website for any changes

VARIATION TO PROGRAM:

The organizers reserve the right to make any changes to the program. Every effort will be made to inform all those affected individually, but notice of the exercising of the abovementioned will be deemed to have been given to all concerned by:-

- a) A notice being placed on the notice board at the bob charter arena.
- b) Announcements being made over the public address system
- c) All changes made to the program will be available on the SASA website:- www.showingsa.co.za
- d) Should it rain during the time of the supreme championship classes, these classes may be held in the indoor the hall. The hall will be available for the exhibitors to familiarize their horses / ponies prior to these classes.
- e) If any of the classes are cancelled due to rain, they will not be rescheduled.

DRESS:

Competitors are requested to be dressed according to the AQHA rules, www.aqha.com, when in any of the arenas, T shirts are not allowed. Approved helmets, corrected fitted and properly fastened, must be worn by any competitor in the over fence classes or when jumping anywhere on the show grounds.

COMPETITOR DISCIPLINE:

The judge's decision is final. Welfare rules regarding the horse and competitor conduct can be found in the AQHA rules (see www.aqha.com). SAEF regulations and AQHA rules will apply in cases where disciplinary action is required

MINIMUM NUMBER OF ENTRIES PER CLASS:

A minimum of number of 4 entries is required to run a class. Should there be less than 4 entries be received, the show organizers reserve the right to combine or cancel classes.

CLASHING OR CLASSES / CROSS ENTRIES:

Whilst every effort will be made to avoid clashes of classes, competitors who make multiple entries do so at their own discretion. Classes cannot be delayed. You are advised to check the provisional timetable thoroughly before entering. The American Paint Horse classes will run concurrently in the same arena as the SAQHA classes, to allow competitors to compete in both the American Paint Horses Classes and the SAQHA classes.

INDEMNITY:

SASA, KYALAMI PARK CLUB AND / OR ANY OF THE BREED SOCIETIES MAY NOT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOSSES, DAMAGES AND / OR INJURIES SUSTAINED BY HORSES, RIDERS, OFFICIALS, THE PUBLIC AND / OR THEIR PROPERTY.

SHOW NUMBERS:

Numbers will be allocated per horse. These numbers are the property of the Kyalami Park Club and a deposit of **R20.00** per number will be charged. The deposit will be given back with the return of number(s). Please return all numbers by the last day of the show or within the week following the show.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

1. Exhibitors are urgently requested to ensure themselves of the starting times of the respective classes, as only two minutes will be allowed between the end of one class, and the commencement of the following class, before the gate will be officially closed. No late comers will be allowed to enter the arena.
2. Exhibitors must enter the arena in program order.
3. Exhibitors must enter the arena via the marshaling area.
4. All scratchings must immediately be brought to the attention of the marshaling steward.
5. In view of the fact that time is restricted due to the many classes and that specific halter and riding classes may be run simultaneously, exhibitors are requested to make provision in advance for sufficient handlers and/or riders to show their horses.
6. Exhibitors should acquaint themselves with the rules applicable to the relevant classes. The AQHA rulebook can be downloaded free of charge from the AQHA website (www.aqha.com) or as a tablet or Cell phone free app.
7. No Novice Youth, Youth and / Novice Amateurs may handle or ride stallions
8. Lead line competitors must be 6 or under and short stirrup competitors must be 11 and under
9. The lead in the lead line class must be connected to a halter underneath the bridle
10. AQHA Rulebook 2013 Equipment rules will apply throughout the duration of the show (AQHA SHW300)
11. Tests for the use of drugs or any other forbidden substances may at any time be required by the show organizer, a list of prohibited substances can be found in the AQHA rule book.
12. No person other than official Stewards will be allowed to enter the arena during judging or to communicate with the Judge/s (or official Veterinarian during examinations).
13. Only the handler or rider will be allowed in the arena whilst judging is taking place.
14. Representatives of an exhibitor may change horses during a class only with the permission of the steward and providing that there is no disruption of the class.
15. All horses shall remain on the Show Grounds at the expense and risk of the owner/handler.
16. All champions, who qualify, must go forward, to show in, the appropriate Horse of the Year Supreme Champion Ridden / Halter class on Sunday the 16 February 2014, in order to retain their championship and the SAQHA points that go with that championship.
17. Patterns for Trail, Horsemanship and Hunt Seat Equitation will be sent out to paid entrants
18. Remember the rider who qualifies for the Supreme Working Riding Champions, class (The overall champion) will be required to jump in the Supreme Working Riding. If you do not attend the class if you qualify for it, You will forfeit your prize, championship and any SAQHA points you may receive for the show
19. Animal welfare and warm up rules apply as per AQHA Rulebook 2013
20. **PLEASE NOTE:** AQHA does not allow cross entering between Western Pleasure and Ranch Pleasure AQHA does not allow cross entering between the mare's halter classes and the broodmare halter class
